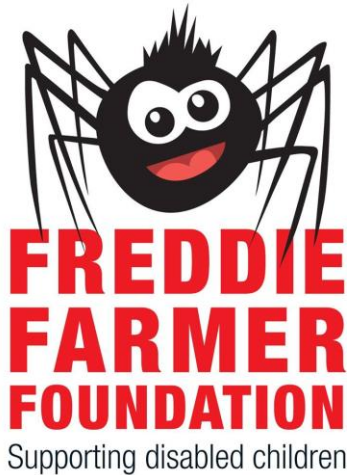

CHRISTMAS CARD SALE FOR FREDDIE FARMER FOUNDATION
